Paul Simons, head of US property treaty and senior vice president at XL, and Christopher Buse, senior vice president and manager of the casualty treaty reinsurance team at XL, collect several awards. The reinsurer scooped the awards for the Best Reinsurer (with GWP of more than \$2bn) for Market Knowledge and for Client Service in the North America market and won the same two categories for the Bermuda market where the large and small reinsurers were judged together.



Bill Donnell, president of US P&C, managing director Americas, Swiss Re collects an award. The reinsurer topped the table in the North America poll winning Best Reinsurer (with GWP of more than \$2bn) for Expertise and Market Knowledge.



Andrew Marcell, CEO of the US Operations of Guy Carpenter, collects several awards. The firm topped the table twice in the North America poll winning Best Broker (with a turnover of more than \$1bn) for Client Service and for Innovation. It also achieved the same feat in the part of the research that applied to Bermuda only.



Bryon Ehrhart, CEO of Aon Benfield Americas, collects the award for Best Broker (with a turnover of more than \$1bn) for Market Knowledge in both the North America and Bermuda markets.



Mike Schnur, partner at TigerRisk Partners, collects an award. The broker topped the table twice in the North America poll winning Best Broker (with a turnover of less than \$1bn) for Innovation and Best Broker for Market Knowledge.
